ORDER:

In the Government Order read above, the Government issued orders, approving the proposal of the Director of Archaeology for declaring the Irumbedu Poondi Arugar Temple (Jain temple), Arani Taluk, North Arcot District to be a protected monument and the Notification for publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette inviting objections and suggestions in regard to the proposal for declaring the above monument to be a protected one as required under sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1900, (Tamil Nadu Act 25 of 1966). No objection or suggestion has been received either by the Government or by-the Director of Archaeolo Madras. The Director of Archaeology has therefore requested the Government to issue Notification declaring the aforesaid monument as a "Protected monument" under sub-section (3) of section 3 of the said Act and has submitted a draft Notification accordingly. Government approved the proposal of the Director of Archaeology and approve the draft Notification submitted by him. The Government also direct that the matters such as appointment of trustees, pools and minor repairs of the temple shall Vested with the Hindu Religiou and Charitable Endowments department.

2. The Notification annexed to this order will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette. The Works Manager, Government Press, Madras is requested to supply 5 copies of the Gazette Notification as published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette to the Government and to the Director of Archaeology, Madras.
