ORDER:

In the G.O. Read above the Government issued orders approving the proposal of the Director of Archaeology for declaring Trilokyanatha Jeeenaswamy Temple in Thiruparuthikundam village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Chengalpattu District as a protected monument and the Notification for publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette inviting objections and suggestions in regard the above monument as a protected one as required under sub-section (1) of Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Ancient and Historical monuments and Archaeological sites and Remains Act, 1966 (Tamil Nadu Act 25 of 1966). No objection or suggestion has been received either by the Government or by the Director of Archaeology, Madras. The Director of Archaeology has therefore requested the Government to issue Notification declaring the aforesaid monument as a "protected monument" under subsection (3) of section 3 of the said Act and has submitted a draft Notification accordingly. The Government approve the proposal of the Director of Archaeology and approve the draft Notification submitted by him.

The Notification annexed to this order will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette. The Work Manager, Government Press, Madras, is requested to supply 5 copies of the Gazette Notification as published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette to the Government and to the Director of Archaeology.


